



2026 Trustees standing down and reappointment

Our constitution requires one third of trustees, or the nearest number, to retire at each AGM. Trustees can stand for re-appointment, but only for up to 3 consecutive terms.

A term is up to 3 years.

The Trustees standing down this year are:

1. Mel Clarke
2. Carmen Jones

They are both standing for reappointment at this AGM.

Our constitution states we need a minimum of 3 and maximum of 12 trustees.

Background info in constitution:

Constitution states:

(a) The charity trustees, must give at least 14 clear days notice of any general meeting to all of the members, and to any charity trustee of the CIO who is not a member.

And

(v) include, with the notice for the AGM, the annual statement of accounts and trustees' annual report, details of persons standing for election or re-election as trustee, or where allowed under clause 22 (Use of electronic communication), details of where the information may be found on the CIO's website.
